The HMII3 Project Team is managing the Historic Miramar Infrastructure Improvements Project Phase 3 (HMII3). The intent of this project is to update the 1950's era water mains, construct new storm drains and swales, and enhance fire protection with additional fire hydrants. It will also provide sanitary sewer services that will allow property owners to abandon their septic tanks once connected to the new sewer system. This project is also aimed at improving stormwater drainage in your neighborhood.

Reynolds Construction continues to make progress during the resotation phase to restore concrete driveways, sidewalks, sprinklers and swales. Paving on Pembroke Road has been completed from SW 68th Avenue to SW 64th Avenue.

On Monday November 4, Reynolds Construction will begin Roadway Restoration and Grading on SW 20th Court West of 66th Avenue. Drainage Sewer Construction will also commence on SW 21st Street from SW 66th Avenue to SW 64th Avenue. Storm drainage is projected to be completed within the next three weeks.


