The HMII3 Project Team is managing the Historic Miramar Infrastructure Improvements Project Phase 3 (HMII3). The intent of this project is to update the 1950's era water mains, construct new storm drains and swales, and enhance fire protection with additional fire hydrants. It will also provide sanitary sewer services that will allow property owners to abandon their septic tanks once connected to the new sewer system. This project is also aimed at improving stormwater drainage in your neighborhood.

The new drainage system has been completed. Reynolds Construction continues to make progress on roadway restoration, including grading and first lift of asphalt on SW 20th Court, SW 22nd Street and SW 66th Avenue. The construction of curbs and sidewalks along SW 19th and 20th Streets remain in progress as well.

Construction activities during the Thanksgiving holiday will be suspended from Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 28, 2019 through Sunday, November 30, 2019. Construction will resume Monday, December 2, 2019.

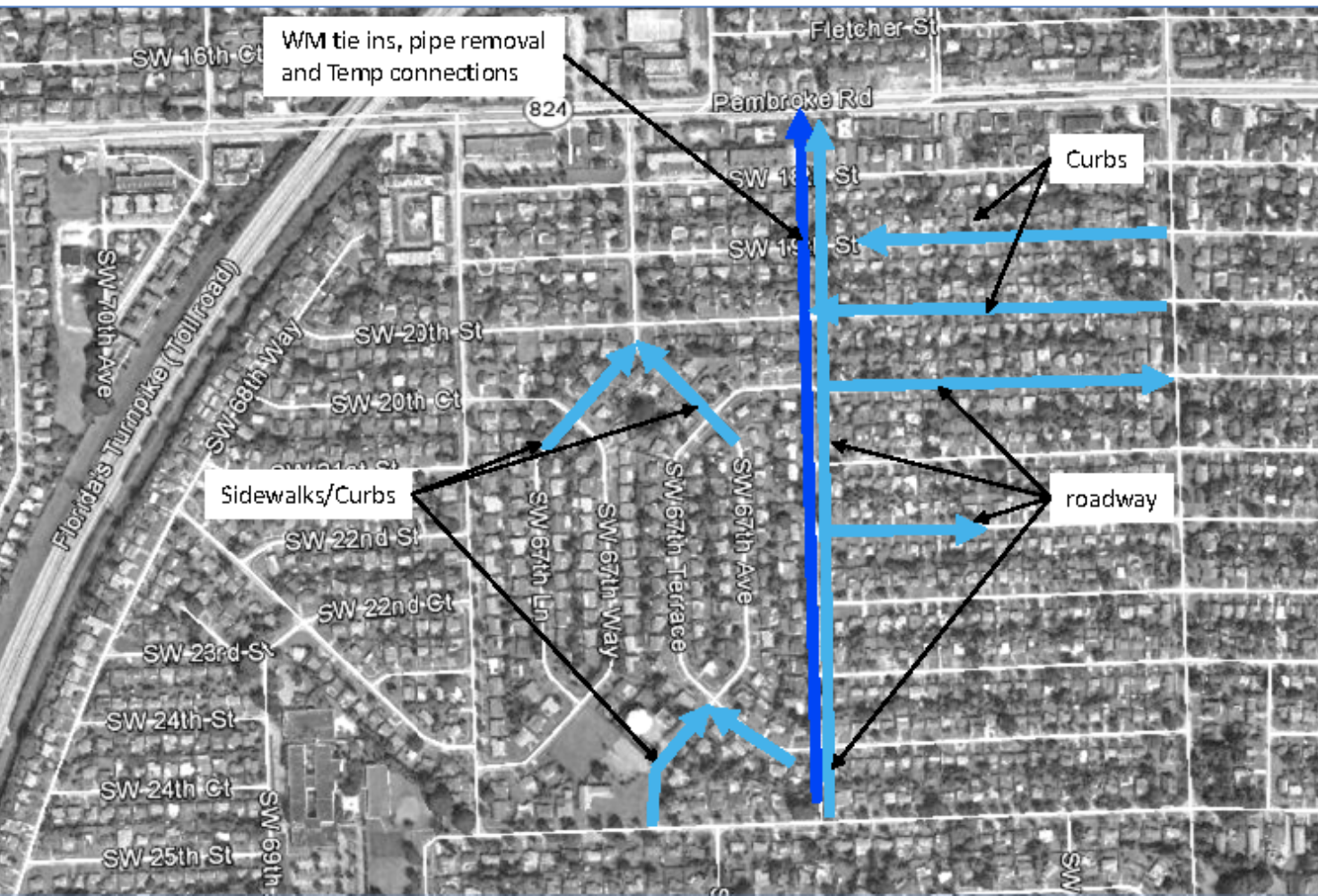
