



HISTORIC MIRAMAR INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (HMII3) Weekly Newsletter Update

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The HMII3 Project Team manages the Historic Miramar Infrastructure Improvements Project, Phase 3 (HMII3). The intent of the HMII3 is to update the 1950's era water mains, construct new storm drains and swales, and enhance fire protection with additional fire hydrants.

Reynolds Construction has completed all the Historic Infrastructure Improvements in Phase 3. They are now focused on restoration of the project area. Roadway Restoration will be done in three phases going east from Sunshine Boulevard to SW 64th Avenue and from Pembroke Road to SW 25th Street.

Reynolds Construction will begin paving the final lift of asphalt between SW 66th Avenue and SW 64th Avenue from SW 22nd Street to SW 20th Court. You may park in the swale and on the driveways. Please do not park in the right of way.

Reynolds Construction will continue to install sod on SW 25th Street from SW 67th Avenue to SW 68th Avenue and SW 64th Avenue from SW 24th Street to SW 25th Street. Please do not park on swales or curbsides.

Shortly, the City of Miramar will communicate when property owners can abandon their septic tanks and connect to the new sewer system.

Resident concerns and claims filed with Adams Consulting Group, Inc. will be inspected individually by Reynolds Construction and the HMII3 team. We ask for your continued patience and understanding as we continue to address your concerns in the HMII3 project area.
