

## Miramar Community Shuttle Service

The City of Miramar and Broward County Transit (BCT) have partnered to provide the Miramar Orange Community Shuttle Route. This free service will increase the number of destinations and connections that can be reached through public transit. Destinations along this route include the Miramar Town Center, Vizcaya Park SW 55 Street, Monarch Lakes Boulevard and Miramar Parkway, Bass Creek Road and Everglades High, Bass Creek and Lakeside Drive, Monarch Lakes Boulevard and Miramar Parkway, Pembroke Road and SW 145 Avenue, and surrounding neighborhoods.

Connections are available to BCT routes 5, 28, 95 Express, and Miramar Green, Miramar Red, Miramar Yellow Community Shuttle Routes.

All buses utilized on this route are air-conditioned and wheelchair accessible in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Bicycle racks are also provided. Please refer to this pamphlet for instruction on how to correctly use the bicycle racks. The Miramar Orange Community Shuttle Route is free of charge, but riders making connections to BCT routes are expected to pay the appropriate fares.

### Hours of Operation

**Monday through Friday**

**6:30 a.m. – 6:27 p.m.**

The Miramar Orange Community Shuttle Route operates approximately every 90 minutes, with assigned stops. Please refer to the timetable and map on the reverse side of this pamphlet. The bus will operate as close to schedule as possible. Traffic conditions or inclement weather may cause the bus to arrive earlier or later than the expected time. Please allow yourself enough time when using this service.

The Miramar Orange Community Shuttle Route will not operate once a hurricane warning has been issued or if other hazards do not allow for the safe operation of the bus.

### Holidays

The Miramar Orange Community Shuttle Route does not operate on weekends or the following holidays observed by the City of Miramar.

New Year's Day • Memorial Day • Independence Day

Labor Day • Thanksgiving Day • Christmas Day

## Bike Racks

Bike racks are available on Miramar Community Shuttles. Racks are designed to carry two bikes only. It is important to have the operator's attention before loading and unloading your bike. As the bus approaches, have your bike ready to load. Remove any loose items that may fall off.

### Loading

- Always load your bike from the curbside of the street.
- Lower-Squeeze the handle and pull down to release the folded bike rack.
- Lift your bike into the rack, fitting the wheels into the slots of the vacant position closest to the bus.
- Latch-Pull and release the support arm over the front tire, making sure the support arm is resting on the tire, not on the fender or frame.

### Unloading

- Before exiting, notify the operator you are removing your bike.
- Pull the support arm off the tire. Move the support arm down and out of the way. Lift your bike out of the rack. If your bike is the only one on the rack, return the rack to the upright position.
- **Move quickly to the curb.**

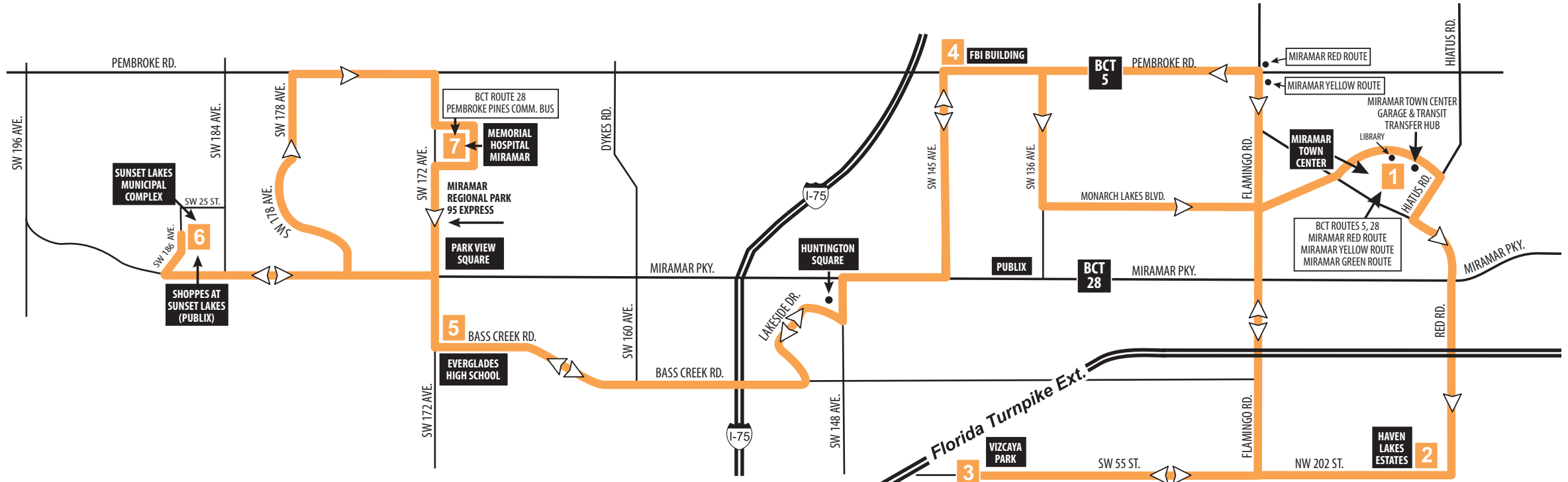
