ORDINANCE NO. 24-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 2-4, "COMPENSATION FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS, SUBSECTION" A. "SALARIES," BY INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR AND EACH COMMISSIONER BY A 5% COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT, RESULTING IN THE SALARY FOR THE MAYOR INCREASING FROM \$43,411 TO \$45,581 AND THE SALARY FOR EACH COMMISSIONER INCREASING FROM \$34,175 TO \$35,884; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City's Charter allows the City Commission to establish the salary and benefits of the Mayor and City Commissioners (sometimes referred to herein as the Elected Officials); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to adopt this Ordinance to amend Section 2-4. A. of the City Code, related to the salaries of Elected Officials; and

WHEREAS, words with single underline shall constitute additions to the original text and strike through text shall constitute deletions to the original text.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are made a specific part of this Ordinance.

Section 2: PURPOSE. AMENDEMENT OF CITY CODE SECTION 2-4.A.

That the following salary and benefits are available to the City's Elected Officials:

A. Salaries. The Mayor shall receive an annual salary of \$43,411 \$45,581. Each City Commissioner shall receive an annual salary of \$34,175 \$35,884.

<u>Section 3:</u> That all sections or parts of sections of the City Code, all ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 4:</u> That should any section or provision of this Ordinance, or any paragraph, section or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof, as a whole or part hereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 5: That it is the intention of the City Commission of the City of Miramar that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code of the City of Miramar, and that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Chapter", "Section", "Article" or such other appropriate word or phrase, the use of which shall accomplish the intentions herein expressed.
