CITY ORDINANCE 18-06

PERMITS FOR INSTALLATION OF COMMUNICATION FACILITIES AND WIRELESS COMMUNICATION FACILITIES WITHIN CITY'S RIGHT-OF-WAY

NOTIFICATION TO PROPERTY OWNERS

The registrant or applicant shall be required to provide notification to property owners adjoining the right-of-way where the work is being proposed. The means of notification shall include but not limited to sending correspondences via US mail. The notifications shall include at a minimum the following:

- 1. Application number.
- 2. Registrant/applicant name, address and contact information.
- 3. A description of the scope of work.
- 4. A sketch delineating the extent of the scope of work and location of proposed aboveground equipment.
- 5. Pictures of proposed aboveground equipment (with dimensions") to be installed.
- 6. Timeframe for work completion.

In addition, the letter shall indicate that the residents should contact the applicant/registrant for information, concerns and/or issues about the project. If concerns or issues are not resolved, the resident may call the City of Miramar at (954) 602-HELP to make an official complaint.

Note: The notification letter shall be review by engineering services prior to be sent out to residents. Applicant shall provide a list of the mailing addresses were the notification letter was sent out.
